



REVISED WORK NOTICE

Field Work being conducted beginning on April 19, 2010

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is re-distributing this revised notice to inform the community of upcoming work at the Former Bay Area Research Extension Center (BAREC) Site, located at 90 North Winchester Boulevard, Santa Clara, California (See attached Figure). **Revisions to the notice are provided in bold below. Additional sampling conducted during 2008 identified four additional areas where soil was found which needs to be removed. The figure was also revised so that it is easier to read.**

Work will be conducted on the Site between 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.

The following work activities will begin on April 19, 2010. This work will take approximately 7 weeks to complete:

- Week of April 19 – Install a 6 foot dust fence around entire site and a 10 foot temporary dust fence around excavation areas and mow excavation areas. Other site preparation work including surveying of excavation areas.
- April 19 thru May 10 - Building Demolition - This includes abatement of lead, asbestos, demolition of buildings and removal of related wastes. This work is not under DTSC's oversight.
- May 6 thru May 24 – Soil Excavation
 - Excavation of approximately 5,000 to 6,000 cubic yards of contaminated soil will be removed from the Site and disposed at an approved offsite facility.
 - Dust control measures such as water spray will be used to minimize dust in the air. Additionally, air monitoring will be conducted to protect both workers at the Site and nearby residents.
 - Confirmation samples will be collected to ensure that cleanup goals for the site are met.
 - **Four smaller excavations of 80 cubic feet each of contaminated soil will be removed and disposed at an approved offsite facility (See Revised Figure).**
 - Daily dust control data will be posted to DTSC's envirostor website and can be viewed at, <http://www.envirostor.dtsc.ca.gov/public/>. Enter Santa Clara in the city section and select Former Bay Area Research Extension Center (BAREC) from the alphabetical list of sites. **Dust monitoring data will be posted to the Community Involvement tab.**
- May 25 thru June 8 – Backfill excavation areas.

All work will be performed in accordance with the Removal Action Work Plan for the Site which was approved by DTSC on October 19, 2007 and a site-specific health and safety plan that complies with both state and federal regulations designed to protect the health and safety of onsite workers and the public.
